20. Tynan's residence. Then post & Telegraph Office
21. Martin Tynan's Richlands Hotel. Mooney's Hotel for many year. Now Taralga Hotel.

23. Once a skating rink and speech hall. Now Bradburys Transport and Rural Supplies.

25. Church of Christ the King. 1934. Displays fine Wombeyan marble.

28. First Catholic complex, convent,school & church, 1867-1884.
